## Industry Emergency Response (IER)

**Title:** HAZMAT Response – 1st Strike Action

**Duration:** 24 hours – 2 Days

**Maximum class size:** 8

**Pre-requisites / Co-requisites:** PUAFIR201B Prevent Injury  
PUAFIR207B Operate breathing apparatus  
PUAFIR306B Render hazardous materials incidents safe

**Location:** Site or at the PWR training Facility

### Minimum individual team member PPE for all courses:

- Reflective Overalls
- Safety Boots,
- Leather Gloves
- Safety Glasses
- Safety Helmet & Chinstrap

### Minimum Equipment List:

- Equipment list as per SCBA Course
- Equipment list as per Fire Suppression Course
- Chemical splash suit, rubber safety boots, chemical gloves (long sleeve) x2
- DECON tarpaulins and contamination storage bins
- Site bulk chemical M.S.D.S sheets, and Emergency procedure guide
- Electrical tape, Brooms, Absorbing agent,
- Neutralizing Agents (if required for caustic chemicals)
- Medical trauma kit and O2 Therapy set
