## Industry Emergency Response (IER) - Course 5

### Title: Road Crash Rescue & Extrication

**Duration:** 36 Hours – 3 Days (an additional 12 hours will include heavy vehicle rescue)

**Maximum class size:** 8

**Pre-requisites / Co-requisites:** PUASAR001B Participate in rescue operations  
PUAEME002C Manage injuries at emergency incident

**Location:** Site or at the PWR training Facility

### Minimum individual team member PPE for all courses:

- Reflective Overalls
- Safety Boots
- Leather Gloves
- Safety Glasses
- Safety Helmet & Chinstrap

### Minimum Equipment List:

- P2 Dust Masks & safety goggles
- Level 2 Structural Fire Suit (Minimum Jacket and Gloves)
- Witches Hats, Tarpaulin for staging area
- Vehicle rescue tool kit – flat head screwdriver, glass cutter 10" & 12" shifter, Pliers, rubber mallet, hack saw & spare blades (Reciprocating saw – if available)
- Trauma 1st Aid Kit, Cervical Collar, Blanket, Resus Unit, KED Unit
- Hydraulic Power Pack, Combi Tool, Parrot beak cutters Hydraulic ram (equipment not available can be supplied by PWR for a nominal fee)
- Cribbing (wood or rubber), Heavy duty rope
